

THE SILVERDALE LUTHERAN CHURCH SCHOLARSHIP

The Scholarship Program

The Silverdale Lutheran Church Scholarship was established to provide two educational scholarship awards annually to eligible candidates of Silverdale Lutheran Church. One scholarship, in the amount of \$4000, is available for a recipient attending a four-year college or university and one scholarship, in the amount of \$2000, is available for a recipient attending a two-year community college or vocational/technical school. Each scholarship will be paid in increments of \$1000 each year to the institution where the student attends. The scholarship program is made possible through a permanently endowed, charitable fund at the Lutheran Community Foundation, made possible by the generosity of Merrill and Elizabeth Koster of Silverdale Lutheran Church.

The Lutheran Community Foundation is a faith-based public charity that exists to provide a connection between donors and the community. Gifts from Lutheran and non-Lutheran donors provide grants nationwide, representing a shared vision to achieve change throughout our community. The mission of the Foundation is to serve our donors with integrity, as together we changes lives and spread joy by sharing our blessings with the world. The Foundation is located in Minneapolis, Minnesota.

Eligibility

Eligible candidates for the scholarship should meet the following criteria:

- 1) Candidates must be members of Silverdale Lutheran Church;
- 2) Candidates must submit an essay of 250 words or less, explaining why they should receive consideration for this scholarship, highlighting their involvement in the church and educational or vocational goals.
- 3) Candidates must submit two letters of recommendation;
- 4) Recipients of the scholarship must remain in good academic standing at the institution where they attend, and it is the responsibility of the recipients to provide such evidence from the institution to the Lutheran Community Foundation. The Lutheran Community Foundation will follow up with renewable scholarship recipients in June;
- 5) These scholarships are not extended to graduate level studies or beyond a four-year or two-year length of time to complete a course of study. Recipients attending a Lutheran affiliated school are not eligible for this scholarship and may apply for the Lutheran scholarships provided by the SLC Council;
- 6) If an applicant is not selected in any given year, they may reapply in subsequent years.

Scholarship Awards

Recipients of these scholarship awards will be notified by the Foundation, and scholarship awards will be sent from the Foundation to the educational institution where the recipient is enrolled.

It is intended that these scholarship awards will provide financial assistance for a recipient's educational expenses that is not otherwise covered by available resources or other financial aid to

the applicant. Funds may be used to defray educational expenses including tuition, books, laboratory expenses, and/or other related educational expenditures as approved by the Foundation.

Selection of Recipients

Scholarship recipients will be determined by the Foundation, based on the above eligibility criteria. The Foundation will not discriminate in the selection of recipients based on race, sex, age, national origin, disability, ethnicity or veteran's status.

Application Process and Deadline

Students who wish to apply to the scholarship program must complete an application.
